Mont Ventoux, the Dentelles de Montmirail, the Luberon... In this coveted Provençal golden triangle, nestled in the heart of the Vaucluse, Crillon le Brave stands apart from the restless hum that descends upon the region each season. At Crillon le Brave, they have set out to write a new story for this exceptional place, one perfectly attuned to the expectations of a discerning French and international clientele.

The essentials that have long defined the allure of this five-star retreat remain untouched: a natural setting of breathtaking beauty, the historic charm of Crillon's honey-hued stone architecture, and an atmosphere of gentle intimacy and understated elegance — all supported by a devoted and discreetly attentive team, and a dining experience renowned for its refined cuisine.

In 2019, interior designer Charles Zana breathed new life into the hotel's common areas, suites, and guest rooms — offering a fresh aesthetic while preserving the soul and character of the estate. The restaurants and bar were reimaged with an entirely new décor, where the timeless spirit of Provence meets a contemporary sensibility.

Now, in 2024, the arrival of Chef Thomas Lesage signals a bold new era of hedonistic culinary experiences — a promise of creativity and delight for the senses.



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CRILLON LE BRAVE IN PROVENCE


A SECRET ROOFTOP FACING MONT VENTOUX

Crowned with snow in winter, scorched by the sun in summer, Mont Ventoux—king of the Vaucluse—rises with majestic presence over the surrounding landscape. A legendary challenge for cyclists from across the globe, who flock here from spring onwards to test themselves against the “Giant of Provence,” this iconic summit watches over the Rhône Valley from its 1,912-metre peak, reigning supreme over the Comtat Venaissin.

Perched on the foothills of Mont Ventoux on one side, with the Dentelles de Montmirail on the other, the medieval village of Crillon le Brave is a jewel of this idyllic Provence — nestled between Malaucène, Mazan, Pernes-les-Fontaines, Bédoin and Saint-Didier, with Carpentras, Avignon and the Luberon just a little further afield. From this private balcony with its uninterrupted view, vineyards and olive groves stretch as far as the eye can see — an unspoilt, timeless vision of pastoral beauty.

A FABULOUS SETTING, RICH IN AUTHENTICITY

Before it became a 12th-century village, Crillon le Brave was first the name of a local hero, the brave Crillon himself, whose bronze statue now welcomes guests just opposite the reception. Here, the hotel blends seamlessly into the fabric of the village, a harmony enhanced by the fact that it is composed of individual private houses, gradually acquired since 1989. Each one has its name, its own story...



Today, nine historic houses form a remarkable architectural ensemble — a charming interweaving of stone buildings, with traditional Genoise eaves, connected by intimate squares, pedestrian lanes and vaulted galleries, opening unexpectedly onto breathtaking vistas. It's an extraordinary labyrinth — the kind one happily loses oneself in, just for the joy of uncovering Crillon's many hidden treasures.

Everywhere, dry-stone walls draped with fragrant climbing plants... flights of weathered stone steps leading to a “so romantic” secret terrace... the village ramparts, pierced by a concealed doorway cut into the ancient wall... shaded pergolas, a singing fountain just above the heated outdoor pool... venerable cypress trees standing sentinel over a forgotten well, and just below, the castle of Crillon with its medieval battlements...

If some places tell a story, Crillon le Brave invites you to live yours — with a childlike sense of wonder rediscovered.





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HERE, TIME LINGERS



AND THE PRESENT MOMENT STRETCHES OUT BENEATH THE SUN...

Some come to leave behind the frantic pace of everyday life — in search of peace, calm, and serenity, to finally reconnect with themselves. Nature and disconnection abound, with yoga and detox available on request.

Others come to indulge in the epicurean pleasures of an abundantly generous Provence — from sun-ripened southern fruits and vegetables to the prized black truffle. *Tuber melanosporum* only.

Some are drawn by the treasures of the Côtes-du-Rhône vineyards, seeking out prestigious labels from Beaumes-de-Venise to Châteauneuf-du-Pape to enrich their cellars.

Then there are those who come to conquer Mont Ventoux by bike — ascending from the hotel's southern side for the ambitious, attempting all three routes in a single weekend for the fearless, or simply enjoying a gentle ride for the contemplative. Here, every dream is welcome.

Others set out to explore nearby artists' studios, museums, and the antique markets of L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue; to applaud performances on and off the main stages of the Avignon Festival, Aix-en-Provence, the Chorégies d'Orange, or the La Roque d'Anthéron Piano Festival. The show is always on.

All are drawn to Crillon le Brave to experience a different kind of Provence — neither celebrity-chic, nor over-touristic, nor bohemian. But rather, hedonistic, elegant, and effortlessly relaxed. Reserved for those who seek refined authenticity, cherished intimacy — the ultimate quest of modern times.

Across the 17 rooms and 17 suites — including a standalone family house — traditional Provençal terracotta tiles (tomettes) set the tone, offering a warm contrast to the understated elegance of the décor. Linen is ever-present, natural hues in soft tonal layers, cosy throws, and gentle textures create a soothing, light-filled atmosphere — an invitation to rest and indulge in luxurious relaxation.

Each room and suite is entirely unique, featuring individually sourced antiques, vintage pieces, and a layout shaped by the character of the house in which it resides. Panoramic bay windows overlooking Mont Ventoux,

picture-frame views of the surrounding countryside, double bathtubs with a view...The interiors reflect the same distinctive charm as the village itself. Nothing is standard — every level reveals its own quiet poetry.



LA TABLE DU VENTOUX

Nestled in the heart of Hôtel Crillon le Brave, La Table du Ventoux offers a truly exceptional culinary experience — where Provençal gastronomy is reimagined with both elegance and authenticity.

Its panoramic terrace, a natural belvedere overlooking the Mont Ventoux valley and its surrounding vineyards, invites guests on a unique sensory journey. Under the expert guidance of talented Chef Thomas Lesage, the restaurant's menu celebrates the richness of Provençal terroir. Each dish, designed to be shared, tells a genuine story of local flavours, evolving harmoniously with the seasons.

Chef Lesage's creations highlight the region's gastronomic treasures: white asparagus from Mazan, traditional Provençal pissaladière, parsley-infused shellfish, or panisse — an iconic Provençal delicacy. Fish such as sea bream fillet or seared tuna share the spotlight with local meats, including Sisteron lamb and rosemary-infused farm pork chop.

A true heir to a family tradition in hospitality, Thomas Lesage draws inspiration from a culinary heritage passed down through generations. From a young age, he was immersed in the love of local produce and a deep respect for artisanal know-how — values that continue to shape his culinary philosophy today.

His cuisine, a heartfelt tribute to the cultures he explored during his travels

The spa is open daily from 10am to 8pm during the season.



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
EMOTIONS & DISCOVERIES

RESISTING THE TEMPTATION TO DO NOTHING...


